Training Day 1: Understanding and Implementing RosettaNet Business Process Standards

Monday, 4 June, 9:00 am – 5:30 pm

This 2-day training course is conducted by RosettaNet expert and staff member Hussam el-Liethy. This course was produced in concert with the centre director and experienced architects from the “RosettaNet Architecture Centre of Excellence,” which was setup at Nanyang Polytechnic (NYP), Singapore, in September 2004 with the sponsorships from government and industry. Participants will receive official course notes from RosettaNet and NYP. The course will be conducted with lecture and presentations, demonstrations as well as class participations. The course is subject to minimum participation.

Pre-registration is required for this course. Cost is \$1,100 in U.S. dollars.

The Council will initially focus on business processes to support the implementation of EPCglobal RFID standards and best practices. Governmental and private sector mandates driving adoption of RFID technologies make this a particularly fertile area for improved choreographies and standardization.
